CAB CONNECTION This taxi voucher subsidy program is available to city of Scottsdale residents who are disabled or senior citizens (65+). The program serves full city limits. HOME SAFE HOME Trained Scottsdale Fire Department volunteers visit seniors in their homes and point out potential tripping and falling hazards.
